RESOLUTION NO. 24-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF WESTLAKE AUTHORIZING THE SPENDING OF \$20,535.74, AVAILABLE THROUGH SALARY SAVINGS, TO ROBERT HALF FOR FINANCE STAFFING SERVICES AND PLACEMENT; AND TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF WESTLAKE:

WHEREAS, Section 252 of the Local Government Code outlines the allowable purchasing methods and thresholds; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has previously authorized the Town Manager to approve budgeted spending only up to \$20,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department is a critical function for the Town that requires qualified staff to adequately safeguard the Town's finances; and

WHEREAS, challenges in the recruiting environment resulted in vacancies of longer than six months and required professional assistance to source qualified candidates; and

WHEREAS, funds are available within the General Fund budget due to the amount saved from the vacant positions and will be transferred to the appropriate account; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the passage of this Resolution is in the best interest of the citizens of Westlake.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF WESTLAKE:

SECTION 1: That, all matters stated in the recitals hereinabove are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION 2: If any portion of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions hereof and the Council hereby determines that it would have adopted this Resolution without the invalid provision.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall become effective from and after its date of passage.
